CLASSES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE OR CANCELLATION

ELECTRONIC TIMER: 5 second time penalty for each knockdown

(Three barrels down is a 15 second penalty)

Make class entry at least two (2) classes in advance

PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN MUST BE PRESENT TO SIGN FOR ALL

CONTESTANTS UNDER THE AGE OF 18

PROOF OF AGE IS REQUIRED FOR REGISTRATION

U.S.A.E. RULES WILL BE FOLLOWED - **JUDGE'S DECISIONS ARE FINAL**

Proper dress required (including suitable footwear) chaps optional

Lead lines will be permitted in **two** classes **ONLY**;

Walk Trot and Apple Bobbing riders 15 years & younger

NO REFUNDS UNLESS HORSE OR RIDER INJURED

HELMETS ARE STRONGLY RECOMMENDED FOR ALL CLASSES

SCHEDULE OF CLASSES – Show Begins Promptly at 8:30 a.m.

1. Halter Class – (NO POINTS, except towards breed awards)
2. Dollar Bareback – (NO stallions permitted)
3. Walk Trot – (x) RIDERS 15 years & younger
4. Open Western Pleasure – ** (RIDER can't enter class #8)
5. Trail Class – **
6. Open English Pleasure – ** (RIDER can't enter class #8)
7. Hunter Hack – (24" fence minimum height)
8. All Day Pleasure (Walk - Trot) – (RIDER can't enter classes #4, #6 or # 10)
HORSE is permitted to cross register
9. Egg & Spoon – (May only support egg during early dismissals)
10. **JACKPOT** Open Pleasure – ** (RIDER can't enter class #8)
11. Command Class
12. Apple Bobbing – (x) RIDERS 15 years & younger (NO POINTS)
13. Catalog Race – (RIDER needing ANY assistance – NO POINTS)
14. Relay Race – (HORSE can only enter once)
15. Crepe' Paper Race – (HORSE can only enter once)

NO CONTACT – Body – Tack – or Horse

Optional break – time permitting

16. Keyhole – (Disqualification for ANY knockdown – NO TIME)
17. Down & Back
18. Thread the Needle
19. Cloverleaf Barrels – RIDER 12 years & younger
(HORSE can't enter #20, #21 or #22)
20. Novice Cloverleaf Barrels – (HORSE can't enter #19, #21 or #22)
21. Cloverleaf Barrels – (HORSE can't enter #19 or #20)
22. **JACKPOT** Cloverleaf Barrels – (HORSE can't enter #19 or #20)
23. Spear the Ring – (minimum at a trot rings & time count)
24. Flag Race
25. Bell Race – (RIDER needing ANY assistance – NO POINTS)
26. Stake Bend
27. Pole Bending – (HORSE can't enter #28)
28. **JACKPOT** Pole Bending – (HORSE can't enter #27)
29. Four Corner Stakes

**** Must register for at least one (1) class marked by ** and JACKPOT OPEN PLEASURE to qualify for "High Point Pleasure Horse" Cash Bonus**

(x) Lead lines will be permitted in **two** classes **ONLY**; Walk Trot (class #3) and Apple Bobbing (class #12) riders 15 years & younger
